Following a direction from the National Legal Services Authority (NALSA), the Tamil Nadu State Legal Services Authority (TNSLA) has directed District Legal Services Authorities (DLSA) and Taluk Legal Services Committees to conduct legal awareness campaigns on various legal issues.

State and District Legal Services Authorities and Taluk Legal Services Committees are making efforts to reach out to common man through legal awareness programmes.

This legal awareness programme, designed by the Taluk Legal Services Committee for college students, is approved by the District Legal Services Authority.

For the 135 crore population of the country, there are less number of courts and hence litigants are not getting timely justice. While holding lok adalats to settle disputes, the authority has been holding events to make people aware of laws.

Legal awareness programme aims to empower the students of our country with the knowledge of their legal rights and duties. In general, it is expected that students must have a better awareness of legal matters.

At this training, the legal aid and programs run by the National Legal Services Authority and the need for those programs to reach out to the poor, downtrodden and exploited citizens of society are to be highlighted. At the same time, the role of students in the successful development and implementation of these programs will be emphasized.

As 50 per cent of the rural population is illiterate and below the poverty line, they are

routinely provided with legal awareness and legal assistance by these type of trained students.

Usilampatti Judicial Magistrate No. 2, **Mr. K. S. Rajeshkumar** M. L., will give this training for the 40 students of our college after the inaugural session.
